DIXIE Blackened Voodoo

New Orleans, Louisiana

Brewed using an exclusive blend of three big, dark-roasted barley malts, a heavy-handed hopping of Mt. Hood and Cascade, then slow, slow, cold lagered. The result is Voodoo... dark, mysterious, and richly flavorful, maybe even a bit on the edge for some.

Milton, Delaware

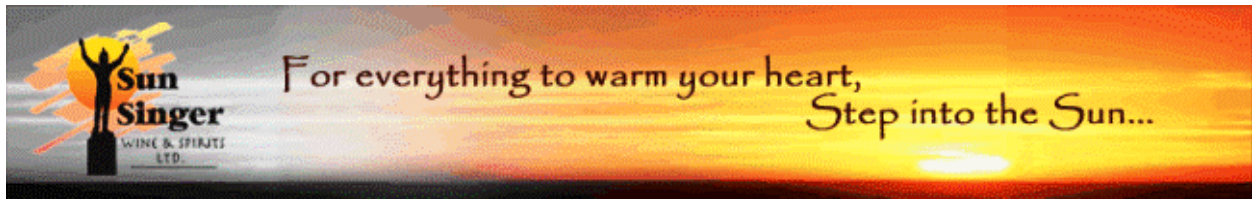

UNITED STATES

LILLY Chardonnay 2005

Sonoma, California

\$17.99

Starts out with crisp green apple flavors and bright acidity. In the middle palate the wine shows tasty oak, a hint of lees and lush chardonnay fruit. The wine finishes with a mix of rich fruit and clean acidity.

DRY CREEK 'The Mariner' Meritage 2004

Dry Creek Valley, Sonoma, California

\$43.99

Appealing aromas of mocha, light vanilla, black cherry-raspberry and wilted roses. Ultrasmooth with medium tannins, the flavors are rich, succulent and nicely concentrated, melding black cherry-cassis fruit, mocha and subtle white pepper. An elegant, stylish wine with a subtle, peppery finish.

EMERSON Pinot Noir 2005

Willamette Valley, Oregon

Dusty rose in color, Emerson Vineyards Pinot Noir is silky and forward, with aromas of plum, black cherry, and subtle, mellow oak. Ripe strawberry and cherry flavors are overlaid by earthy nuances of truffle. Finishes with gentle tannins and a hint of spice. Pair with salmon, roast fowl, or polenta.

THURSTON WOLFE Syrah 2005

Stags Leap District, Napa, California

Look for bright aromas of blackberry and cherry with notes of spicy oak and tar. The palate is bursting with ripe black fruits and offers a long, rich finish with hints of vanilla and oak.

HELIX Pomatia Red 2003

Columbia Valley, Washington

50% Cabernet, 27% Merlot, 16% Syrah & 7% Cab Franc. This bombshell of a wine will send you reeling with it's toasted cedar backbone and hearty cherry marmalade. With intensely flirtatious flavors of worcestershire and soy sauce.

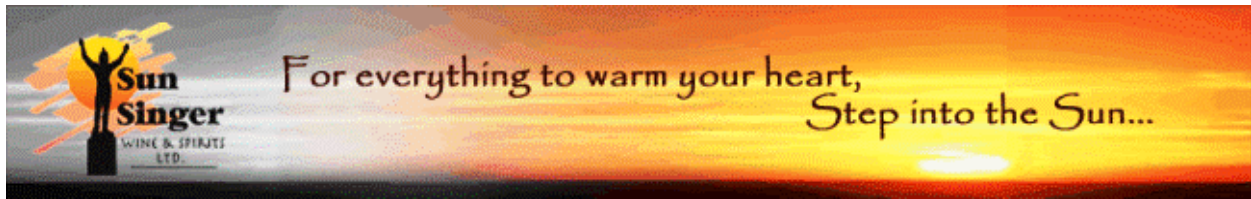
ITALY

VILLA CAFAGGIO Chianti Classico 2005

Tuscany, Italy

\$22.49

Aged approximately 1 year in Slavonian oak and at least 6 months in the bottle, the wine is rich and elegant with ripe fruit, supple tannins and a long spicy finish.



VILLA CAFAGGIO Chianti Classico Riserva 2004

Tuscany, Italy

\$30.99

The wine is aged in small oak barrels and matured in bottle for more than 6 months prior to release. With lush, complex fruit and spicy aromas, this Riserva has real concentration and depth.

FRANCE

CHRISTOPHE DENIZOT Domaine des Moirots 'Givry' 2005

Givry, Burgundy, France

\$20.99

100% Pinot Noir. A favorite wine of King Henry IV. The Givry is a small vineyard in the Cote Chalonnaise which has been maintained by the family since 1763. This wine ages in barrel for 8 months.

CH de TIREGAND Grand Millesime-Percharmant 2005

Bergeracc, France

\$24.99

58% Merlot, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon, 16% Cabernet Franc 6% Malbec. Full bodied and fresh.

CH de CAZENOVE 2004

Bordeaux Superieur, France

\$14.99

A blend of 20% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Cabernet Franc and 75% Merlot. The Cazenove vineyard is next to southern Margaux, but its wines do not need to be kept so long. It is already generously full and soft, and a chunk of good peacote, even gherkins, go well with it. The rich fruit is expressed by a long fermentation on the skins. Oak barrel ageing for one year adds complexity to the elegant and balanced finish.
