ATOMIUM

Belgium

California

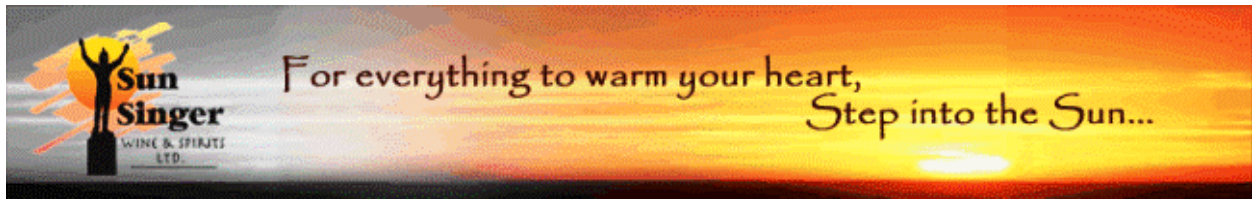

WINES

ITALY

Pignocco Verdicchio di Castelli di Jesi 2006

\$19.49

Santa Barbara, Italy

The nose reveals clean and pleasing aromas which start with hints of pear and apple followed by aromas of hawthorn, chamomile, broom and almond. In the mouth has good correspondence to the nose, a crisp attack and however balanced, delicate, intense flavors. The finish is persistent with flavors of apple and pear.

POGGIOANTONORA 'La Peghera di Baccio' Chianti Classico 2005

\$17.99

Italy

Produced since 1992 in the old 'ricasoliana' way, with a percentage of white grapes (Malvasia del Chianti and Trebbiano). It is a ruby red shading to garnet-red and has a flavoured scent and a delicate, velvety and balanced taste.

SANDILIANO Barolo Reserva 2001

\$47.99

Piedmonte, Italy

Ethereal and intense nose with spicy notes of mint. Well structured with a very harmonious balance and a long austere after taste.

NEW ZEALAND

TeAWA Sauvignon Blanc 2006

\$22.49

Hawkes Bay, New Zealand

A distinctly different style of Sauvignon Blanc than that found in Marlborough, this is riper and rounder, with more potential for evolution in the bottle. Notes of citrus custard mark the bouquet, while flavors veer towards melon and fig, with hints of peach or nectarine. It's velvety textured, and long on the finish.

TeAWA Merlot 2002

\$16.49

New Zealand

A well-balanced wine with concentrated but restrained flavours and fine tannins. This wine displays the classical varietal characteristics in its soft generous attack with cherry and plum flavours. An underlying mineral note gives an added dimension and distinction on the nose and palate. A subtle dark chocolate character comes through on the finish along with the cherry and mineral notes.

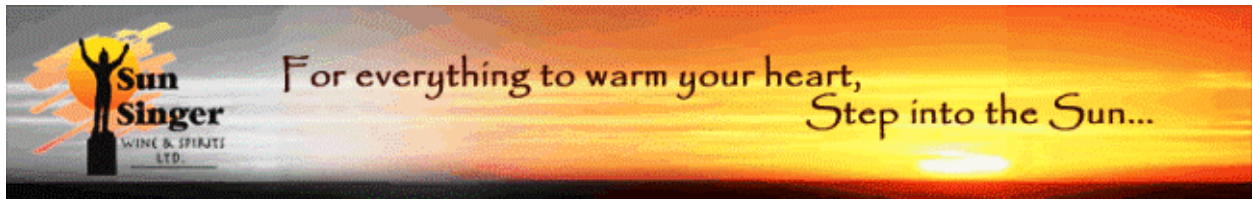
SPAIN

BODEGAS BORSO Monte Oton 2006

\$9.99

Spain

Borsao has now produced this great tasting Garnacha. Very clean and fresh, with lots of easy fruit and a pleasant finish. There is no oak aging on this wine.



AUSTRALIA

PENNY'S HILL Shiraz 2004

\$33.99

Australia

Deep ruby. Intensely aromatic nose combines bitter cherry, dark chocolate, candied licorice, dried violet and black tea. Fat, lush and creamy, with dark fruit flavors given shape by supple tannins. The fruit notes grew deeper and sweeter with air, and complicating smoked meat and baking spices emerged. This impressive, concentrated shiraz needs time in bottle.

S. C. PANNELL Shiraz 2005

\$38.99

Australia

Highly perfumed boysenberry and blueberry aromas are enlivened by exotic floral pastille, vanilla and incense notes, plus a subtle hint of graphite. Suave and silky in texture, showing impressively pure dark berry and fresh cherry flavors on a midweight frame. Whatever tannins might be here are buried under an avalanche of pure, sweet fruit. Downright sexy shiraz, finishing sweet and long, with a persistent candied violet note.

S. C. PANNELL Shiraz/Grenache 2005

\$38.99

Australia

The 2005 Shiraz/Grenache (80% Shiraz from 45-year-old vines and 20% Grenache from 70-year-old vines) spent time in large French barrels. It reveals beautiful, seamless blackberry and black raspberry aromas interwoven with scents of licorice, tar, and spice box. This expressive, superbly endowed wine will offer superb complexity over the next 5-7 years.
