CONO SUR '20 Barrels' Cabernet Sauvignon 2006

This cabernet delivers a beautiful, deep ruby red color. Intense notes of plum, cassis, and blueberries combined with softer earthy traces, mocha and smoke. Full bodied and intense with a persistent and elegant finish.

UNIQUE Sauvignon Blanc 2007

Loire Valley

The 'Unique' is a single estate wine made from 100% Sauvignon Blanc grown on a small family estate close to the famous Loire Valley chateau of Chenonceaux and Chambord.

CHATEAU GRAVILLE-LACOSTE 2007

Graves, Bordeaux

Having enjoyed a solid reputation in the past, this bourgeois wine continues to offer correctness and seriousness. The Arnaud family has never forget the simple rule: let the terroir speak for itself, with Cabernet-Sauvignon ruling supreme here. The wine-making process is in true Médoc style, producing wines which should be left for several years.

DOMAINE D'AUPILHAC 'Lou Maset' 2006

Coteaux du Languedoc

Located in the south of France this estate has been in their family for over five generations. Each stage, from planting right through to the unfiltered bottling, is done with a respect for nature, the soil and the vines. This blend of 30% Grenache, 30% Cinsault, 20% Syrah, 10% Alicante Boushet, and 10% Aramon comes from grapes that are hand picked at maturity from low yielding vines and matured in old cask.
